\$50,000 CLASSROOM RENOVATIONS


Upgrades to existing classrooms to feature contemporary design, accessibility, furnishings to enhance learning and peer collaboration, and to accommodate instructional technology.

\$136,000 RENOVATION OF STAFF HOME


There remains need to renovate one older staff home in order to improve and update its living environment. Providing quality accommodations encourages staff to remain at the Village, which gives youth consistency in adult role models.

\$175,000 DAY CARE CENTER FOR STAFF FAMILIES

Yemin Orde's dedicated staff with young children are in need of a safe and affordable care option in a loving environment while they are at work in the Village. Currently, the Village does not have a nearby day care option for children aged 3 months to 3 years old.

\$325,000-\$375,000 STAFF NEIGHBORHOOD


Yemin Orde's staff is available 24/7 for our at-risk youth. We are constructing a staff neighborhood consisting of apartments containing safe rooms/bomb shelters and a special system for protection against chemical warfare. There will be eight apartments costing \$325,000/each, and three apartments costing \$375,000/each.

\$425,000 RENOVATION OF CHILDREN'S HOME


There is need to renovate one remaining older children's home in order to unify the living standards across all homes. The renovated home will have an updated and enhanced living environment as well as upgraded kitchen, bathroom and safety features.

\$950,000 MANAGEMENT AND ADMINISTRATIVE OFFICES


Current offices are housed in several temporary structures brought into the Village following the December 2010 fire. A new building would provide a centralized office and unify the Village's management teams.

\$1,300,000 ONE CHILDREN'S HOME


A new and modern children's home to feature updated enhanced living environments as well as upgraded kitchen, bathroom and safety features.
